

Virtual Interviewing Practice

An increasing number of finance firms are using video for first-round and even final-round interviews. Some video interview formats are interactive and in real time (e.g. a Skype conversation), while others require the interviewee to record responses to provided questions. To hone your video interviewing skills, we suggest using the video interview practice in [CareerBeam](#), a career planning resource offered by the [Duke Career Center](#). You are able to select the types of question to which you would like to respond, make video recordings, and save your recordings for future reference.
